 The book explains the basic principles of traditional acupuncture (e.g. 5 Elements, 8 Principles, Co-Cycle, Sheng Cycle) in a very easy understandable way.








MRSA Infected Wounds

Methicillin-resistant Staphylococcus aureus (MRSA) infection by Dr Uwe Petermann DVM Melle Germany

German Shepherd mix, 3-years-old, male, has been presented for LLT Local Laser Therapy and LA Laser Acupuncture to treat a 12 cm linear wound in the dorsal right shoulder area parallel to the vertebral spinous processes. Bacterial culture with antibiotic sensitivity had verified a Methicillin-resistant Staphylococcus aureus (MRSA) infection. The wound had been treated unsuccessfully for four 4x months in a small animal hospital and euthanasia was recommended.

When the dog was presented for treatment, the wound was characterized by a highly destructive, infiltrative infection. The granulation tissue contained multiple fistulous tracts with marked secretory activity (see photos). When treatment commenced, antibiotics & anti-inflammatory drugs were discontinued (Photos Dr Uwe Petermann DVM)

I chose to add the 150W focus cluster to the 300W laser for practical reasons. The 300W laser is excellent for spinal problems and large joints/areas.

So the 150W is ideal for the treatments of the areas mentioned above, and it also works well in wound treatment, where the focus (due to the programmation) is not on deep tissue penetration, but more superficial.


I am not sure if that is what the 150W laser had been build for, but I have used it now in 6 different cases of nasty wounds with very nice results. Again, it works better and faster then I ever could achieve with the ASA or K laser before.

For the smaller animals like chihuahua's, cats and others, and also for small treatment areas, as fingers, head, teeth, oral- and other cavities, tail etcetera etcetera, I use the 90W laser pen. Also when I make house calls, the laser pen comes with me, because it can also be used for large dogs and large joints.

The three lasers are for me an ideal combination.

I always use the Vessel applicator with laser acupunture as part of my protcol. Focused Cluster Probe 150 Watts is sometimes included as well as Derma multiprobe. Sometimes alone for treatment reinforcement in complementary sessions.

My results improved when I started using the Vessel Applicator.
